

PHOTOGRAPHY TRANSITION WORK

PLEASE COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING TASKS:

TASK 1: Research the term 'Formal Elements' in relation to photography. Construct a list and their definition.

TASK 2: Photograph a set of images inspired by your researched list. Shoot minimum 2 images for each formal element you have found. There is no right or wrong way to approach your shoot and you can shoot using any device e.g. phone/ digital camera/ tablet. There are lots of examples online of illustrated lists of the formal elements, look at them for inspiration then try to shoot in your own way. Be as creative as possible, experiment with viewpoint and composition, subject and approach.

Here's a few ideas- shoot up, shoot down. Shoot through things, close up, consider the lighting- direction/ time of day

Please bring your completed list of formal elements and definitions and your images to enrolment day/ your first lesson. These do not need to be printed but you need to be able to access them e.g. have your list on a google doc/ cloud/ Microsoft one drive, photos on your phone or if shot on a camera bring your SD card.
