Getting to JLC is easy. We are located in Scunthorpe, North Lincolnshire, with transport links coming from all surrounding areas. We run a variety of bus routes to ensure our students have a smooth journey.

Students aged 16-18 years may be eligible for travel assistance from their Local Education Authority (LEA) Post-16 Travel Scheme.

If you live within 3 miles of JLC

If you live more than 3 miles from JLC

Travel Passes for 2024/25 cost £90 for the academic year. We offer a payment plan with payment made in three termly instalments of £30 (paid Sept/Jan/Apr).
